To understand and respect the differences and similarities between people. To understand that the creation of new life requires a male sperm and a female egg. To learn that female mammals give birth and nurse their young. 	Summer 1
Year 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know some differences and similarities between males and females To name male and female body parts accurately. 	Spring 1
Year 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To identify changes in the human life cycle. To use the correct names of female and male reproductive organs To describe the effects of puberty on male and female bodies. To begin to understand periods and how to be keep clean during puberty. To understand that there may be changes in moods and emotions during puberty. 	Summer 2
Year 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To explain the main physical and emotional changes that happen during puberty and how to manage these changes. To ask questions about puberty with confidence. To understand how puberty affects the reproductive organs. To explain how to stay clean during puberty. To know how to get help and support during puberty. 	Summer 1
Year 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To describe how and why the body changes during puberty in preparation for reproduction. To consider physical and emotional behaviour in relationships To understand in simple terms what is meant by 'consent'. To know some basic facts about conception and pregnancy. 	Autumn 2
