BREAKFAST AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE SPACES AVAILABLE

We are excited to restart our breakfast and after school club in John Ball school and to see so many familiar and friendly faces. We are also eager to meet new families and currently have spaces on all days at breakfast and after school club for children in Reception class through to year 6. So, if you are thinking of changing your current days, or would like to find out more about our Outstanding graded service, please get in touch by phone or email.

Our aim is to offer fun and affordable childcare to John Ball families.

As an Ofsted registered provision, we accept childcare vouchers, Government tax-free childcare scheme and families may be eligible for up to 85% of childcare costs through Universal Credits.

Our year group bubbles have an allocated play space, dedicated selection of resources and separate outdoor play areas. Children in Reception class have their very own Early Years room. Year 1 and 2 bubbles are based in the Superkids classroom, and year 3,4,5 & 6 have zoned areas in the KS1 hall.

Breakfast club runs from 7.30am to 9am. Following a warm welcome, children enjoy a nutritious breakfast from a selection of wholegrain cereals, bagels, waffles, pancakes, toast and yogurt. A range of activities are set out in each bubble, which includes educational games, large construction sets, art activity, puzzles, and books. Superkids staff safely guide children to their class or key stage area according to their staggered start time.

After-School Club from 2.45pm-5.45pm. The team collects Reception and KS1 children directly from their class at the end of the school day. Children's independence is encouraged as KS2 children make their own way to the Superkids area. The session begins with registration followed by healthy snack with vegetables and fruit. Children have free choice of activities and daily outdoor play under supervision of the Superkids team. Children in Year 3-6 also enjoy games and sports in the KS2 outdoor areas.

Maintaining a Covid-safe environment - Superkids is working in partnership with John Ball and following guidance from the Dept of Education and the Out of School Alliance to ensure we are working in a way that maintains the health and wellbeing of your children, our staff and the school community. (Risk assessment available on request).

Our protective measures include:

- Small consistent bubbles according to year group who will not mix during the session.
- Children are guided to wash hands regularly and sanitiser is available throughout the session.
- Children are encouraged to enjoy outdoor activities on all days, weather permitting.
- Activities have been adjusted to ensure resources can be cleaned effectively between use and to maintain distance with others in the same bubble where possible.
- Parents and carers dropping off or collecting their child are asked to follow the directional signage and we will sign children in or out on your behalf.
