We have limited edition 2021 Heath for Health medals thanks to Hamptons, The Home Experts, Blackheath.

The money raised will be split two ways. Crisis Fund provides immediate financial support for families facing a crisis in their lives. Mrs Parish has a close, working relationship with the charity as they have provided many John Ball families with grants over the years. They have provided funds for the purchase of fridges, cookers, washing machines, beds and mattresses. They have awarded nearly every application Mrs Parish has made, so we would like to thank them for their continued support and generosity. As always, we also aim to raise funds for John Ball outdoor learning.

How to participate:

- Participation is free but we would like to suggest a £5 donation per entrant which can be paid via www.virginmoneygiving.com/fund/H4H Please use your family name for donations so we can link to your submitted activity evidence. We, obviously, welcome children to collect sponsorship online and are welcome to set up their own fundraising link via www.virginmoneygiving.com/fund/H4H
- You'll then need to track/ log your exercise. This can be via Strava, Nike Running, Garmin or any other activity tracker. (Photos and times also accepted if you don't have an activity tracker app) Please email evidence and list of participants (including 'current' JB class if applicable) to Heathforhealth@live.com We may share your achievements on our social media accounts so please do indicate if you are NOT happy for us to do so. Remember to let us know your family name so we can link to your donation and prepare your medals.
