On Tuesday our staff team had a range of professional development activities relating to inclusion and safeguarding. This included:

- a second part to our dyslexia training looking at strategies to support children with dyslexia in the classroom,
- learning and exploring the Brooks traffic light tool to help identify when sexualised behavior is age and developmentally appropriate or if it is potentially harmful,
- Understanding the Prevent Duty, the relevant part to school of the UK's counter terrorism strategy

In line with this, we are delighted to welcome OpenView Education to support us in delivering our annual e-safety learning to students. As part of this, they will be offering a **parent workshop** exploring ways to keep children safe online.
